Prize giving ceremony – protocol

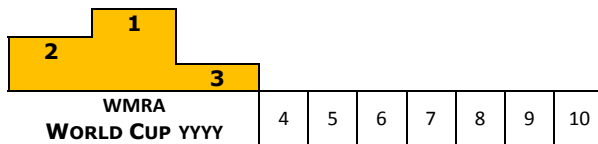
(Appendix 3 to the WMRA WCup Regulations)

1. GENERAL

- 1.1. The WMRA **WORLD CUP** Prizegiving Ceremony (**WCup** PGC) should be organised in the time after the last **World Cup** race as a part of the event. The place and time of WMRA **WORLD CUP** PGC must be clearly defined in the propositions of the event.
- 1.2. Presentation of prizes to the overall **WORLD CUP** prize winners will take place immediately after the presentation of the overall race prizes and before the races other category or local prizes. A WMRA representative should be invited to say a few words.
- 1.3. If the race is on Saturday, **WORLD CUP** PGC could be also organized as a separate arrangement on the evening of the race – in this case additional overnight stay for at least the prize-winners is obligatory.

2. ARRANGEMENT AND PROGRAMME

- 2.1. Podium for the best 3 placed with wording »**WMRA WORLD CUP YYYY** (where YYYY = year of event)« should be prepared and enough space for the other men/women prize winners should be provided:



- 2.2. The banner or flag with the WMRA logo (it could be the same one that is used for the finish banner) should be placed in a visible place.
- 2.3. Speaker should announce the ceremony.
- 2.4. A WMRA representative should hold a short speech (max 2 min) as indicated in 1.2 above.
- 2.5. WMRA **WORLD CUP** prizes according to the “WMRA **WORLD CUP** Regulations” should be prepared and presented by WMRA representative & LOC representative.
- 2.6. An envelope containing request for athlete bank payment details and contact should be prepared in advance of the ceremony.
